- Have contract with City to oversee Emergency Assistance Program-\$ 86,000
- Community Action Program primarily serves youth in the community-Youth Summit and Summer Youth Program
- Supervisor gave impassioned speech about the need for the Township
- Township Assessor, Sharon Eckersell, gave her report, commenting on her decreased staff and the number of residents she has helped throughout the year (deputy assessor eliminated this year)
